

# Recent incidents (Red Sea / Bab el Mandeb / Gulf of Aden)

Below is a list of incidents directly affecting merchant ships in the Red Sea, the Bab el Mandeb and the Gulf of Aden which have been recorded on the Risk Intelligence System during the past 30 days. Information includes date, time and a short description of the respective incident. Comprehensive descriptions for all incidents (as well as for older incidents) can be found on the Risk Intelligence System.

<b>17 March</b>	<b>02:05 UTC</b>	<b>LPG tanker MADO targeted</b>
The ship was targeted with at least two missiles while transiting eastbound through the Gulf of Aden. The vessel was not struck and all crew are safe.		

<b>23 March</b>	<b>14:35 UTC</b>	<b>Crude oil tanker HUANG PU struck</b>
The ship reported being struck by a missile which caused a fire onboard. The crew extinguished the fire and the vessel proceeded to next port of call, southbound.		

<b>1 April</b>	<b>19:56 UTC</b>	<b>Cruise ship CRYSTAL SYMPHONY hailed and targeted</b>
The ship reported being hailed by an entity claiming to be the "Yemeni Navy", requesting they turn on their AIS, while transiting the BAM. Crew reported small arms fire to have hit the vessel. No casualties.		

<b>6 April</b>	<b>Unknown</b>	<b>Container vessel HOPE ISLAND targeted</b>
The ship reported being targeted by two missiles. One was intercepted by coalition forces whereas a second splashed a distance from the vessel. No damage reported and vessel proceeded to next port of call.		

<b>7 April</b>	<b>05:03 UTC</b>	<b>Container vessel HOPE ISLAND targeted again</b>
The Joint Maritime Information Centre in the UK reported three separate launches against the vessel as well as drone activity prior to the launches. Vessel reported new missile splash in close proximity but no damage.
