

Charterer's Liability for Pollution Insurance

INTRODUCTION

There may be occasions where member as charterer may be held liable for pollution as owner of the cargo, as opposed to, or in addition to, member's capacity as charterer of the vessel.

WHAT IS COVERED?

Skuld's Charterer's Liability for Pollution Insurance is afforded to member for liability as cargo owner for oil pollution. Coverage includes:

- Liability for the actual or threatened escape or discharge from the vessel of oil or other polluting substance
- Costs of measures reasonably taken for the purpose of preventing or minimising pollution
- Costs incurred (excluding fines) in order to comply with an order of any government or authority for the purpose of preventing or minimising actual or threatened pollution.

The total sum insured is the limit that member elects to purchase.

WHO CAN BE COVERED?

Any member of Skuld who has a full charterer's entry for combined P&I/CLH in the Association can apply for Skuld's Charterer's Liability for Pollution Insurance. The cover is usually offered on a per annum basis.
