

Voyage Charterers' Comprehensive Cover (VCCC)

INTRODUCTION

Members who voyage charter vessels may have more extensive involvements than the sea leg part of the cargo carriage. Contracts for carriage are not just confined to the carriage by sea, but could be extended to road, rail and/or air. There might also be occasions where the carriage does not involve any vessel voyage chartered by members. During the various legs of transportation, the cargo might have to be stored in warehouse for extensive periods. Attaching to these extensive involvements could be extensive liabilities on voyage charterers that fall outside the standard scope of P&I.

WHAT IS COVERED?

Skuld's Voyage Charterers' Comprehensive Cover (VCCC) covers the member for

- 1) P&I as per Skuld's charterers' rules;
- 2) Charterers' Liability to Hull as per Skuld's standard CLH terms;
- 3) FD&D as per Skuld's standard FD&D terms;
- 4) Liabilities in respect of loss of and/or damage to cargo arising out of:

- through transport liabilities hereunder warehousing and storage onboard of vessel and/or barge;
 - member in his capacity as non-vessel operating common carrier NVOCC
- 5) Liabilities, costs and expenses incurred for:
 - third party personal injury and death arising out of cargo handling equipment owned and/or leased by member;
 - third party property damage arising out of cargo handling equipment owned and/or leased by member;
 - 6) Liabilities, costs and expenses in respect of member in his capacity as cargo owner for:
 - oil pollution including sue & labours costs;
 - cargo liabilities due to the nature of cargo;
 - environmental damages;
 - third personal injury and death;
 - third party property damage

WHO CAN BE COVERED?

Any member of Skuld who is involved in voyage charter of vessels.
